

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Member's Appointments with your Members of Parliament

Please point out to your MP that the claim by the Ministry of Defence that we are not alone in our claim for Occupational Pensions & Gratuities, and that other Public Employees would also have to be considered, is totally incorrect and yet one more false pretence.

Refer them to our Researched Report & Addendums CAFF UK 2008 – 2 Copies are held in the House of Commons library.

Also point out that the Social Security Act 1973 Schedule 16 set up an “Occupational Pensions Board”. Managers of 'all' Occupational Pensions Schemes both Public and Private were required to submit their Schemes for approval by the OPB to ensure they conformed with the OP Board's requirements to introduce transitional and transfer arrangements of previous years of service prior to the appointed day i.e. 6th April 1975.
